You will be responsible for updating and maintaining the Aquatic Pool Safety Plan, informing management of pool maintenance, equipment and supplies requirements; discussing any concerns, issues or problems with pool patrons; aquatics programming; coordinating and conducting in-service training; and orienting new aquatics staff.
