



2026 BOSTON BAR AND NORTH BEND TELEVISION ASSENT VOTE

NOTICE OF ASSENT VOTING OPPORTUNITY

PUBLIC NOTICE is given to electors within the Boston Bar and North Bend Closed Circuit Television Service Area, in a portion of Electoral Area A of the Fraser Valley Regional District, that a vote will be held on the following question:

“Are you in favour of ending the Boston Bar and North Bend Television Service Area by the Fraser Valley Regional District adopting Repeal Bylaw No. 1829, 2026?”

The full text of the bylaw may be inspected at the office of the Fraser Valley Regional District at 45950 Cheam Avenue, Chilliwack, BC from September 17, 2026 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, excluding holidays. VOTER REGISTRATION

Registration will take place at the time of voting. Voter requirements:

- 18 years of age or older as of general voting day (October 17, 2026)
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months before the day of registering to vote;
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the Boston Bar and North Bend Closed Circuit Television Service Area,
- not otherwise disqualified by law from voting, and
- entitled to vote and have not previously voted in this assent vote.

NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS

In addition to the above, non-resident property owners (NRPEs) must:

- not be entitled to register to vote as a resident elector in the Boston Bar and North Bend Closed Circuit Television Service Area;
- have owned property in the Service Area for at least 30 days before registering to vote;
- all be individuals registered on title. If there is a corporation on title, none of the owners are eligible to vote as an NRPE;
- only register to vote in relation to one property in the Service Area;
- be a registered owner of real property as described in Section 66(4) of the Local Government Act.
- register only one of the owners AND obtain written consent from the majority of those on title to vote on behalf of that property. Consent forms can be obtained prior to the time of voting from www.fvrd.ca/elections or by contacting elections@fvrd.ca

Corporations are not entitled to vote or to have a representative vote on their behalf

IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Resident electors: 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) which should together prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors: 2 pieces of identification to prove identity (at least one with a signature) AND proof that you are entitled to register in relation to the property (title search or, tax notice AND, if applicable, a consent form signed by the other owners of the property).

APPLICATIONS TO VOLUNTEER TO ACT AS A SCRUTINEER

Qualified electors in the Service Area may apply to volunteer as a scrutineer for or against the question to be voted on. Applications to volunteer to act as a scrutineer are available at www.fvrd.ca/elections or at the offices of the Fraser Valley Regional District at the address noted below, on weekdays between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., excluding holidays.

Applications will be received beginning at **8:30 a.m. September 21, 2026** and ending at **4:30 p.m. October 1, 2026**. Appointments will be made by the Chief Election Officer on October 2, 2026.

Interested persons may obtain additional information regarding volunteering to be a scrutineer by contacting the Chief Election Officer.
