

EVACUATION ALERT RESCIND

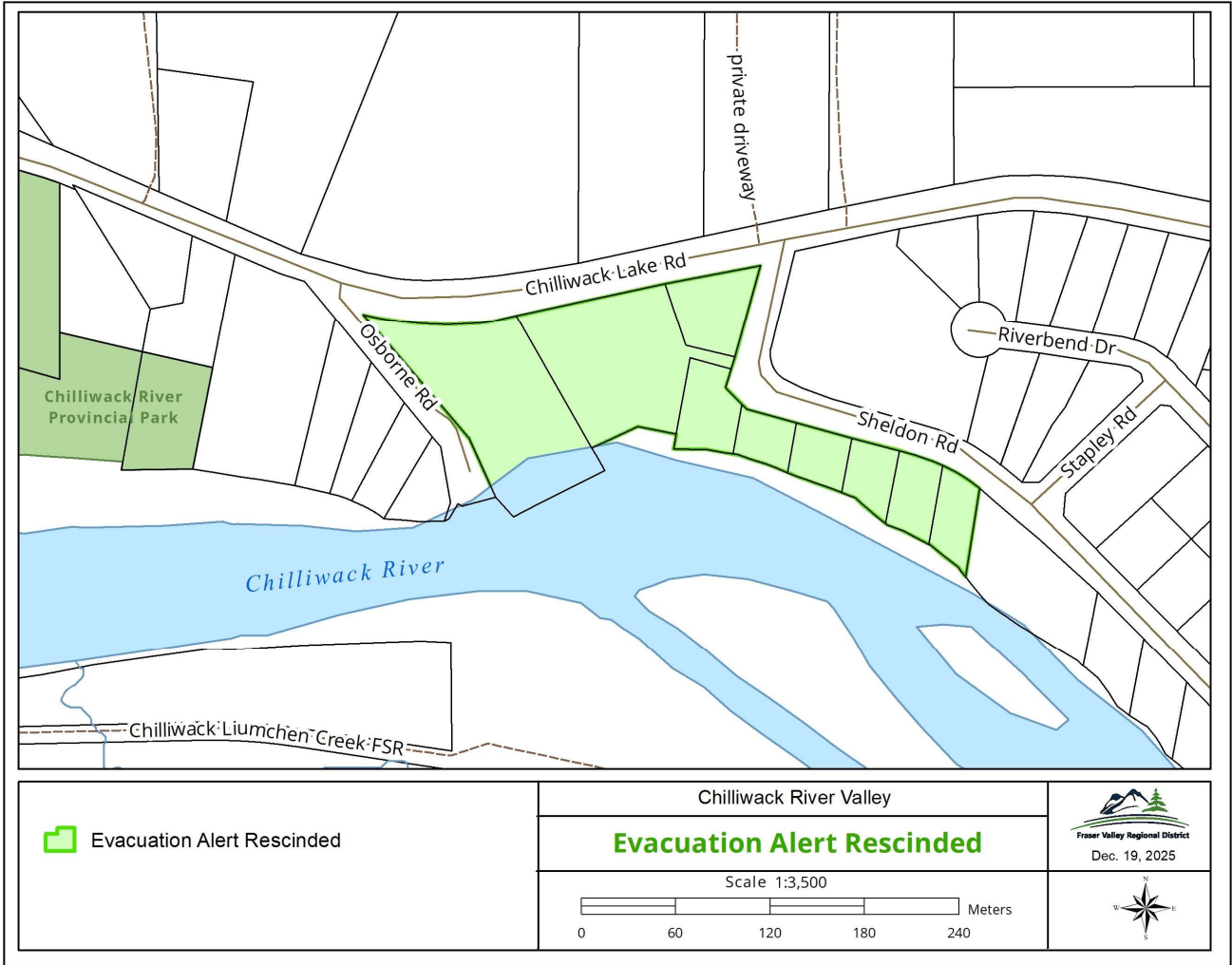

Electoral Area E – Sheldon Road Area

The **Evacuation Alert** issued by the Fraser Valley Regional District Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) on December 15, 2025 at 11:30 am for the Sheldon Road area has been **rescinded**. An Evacuation Alert or Order may need to be reissued; however, if that is deemed necessary, the Evacuation Alert/Order process will re-commence.

The Evacuation Alert has been rescinded/cancelled from the following properties:

The period of flood risk associated with the December 10-11, 2025 atmospheric river event has sufficiently subsided for this alert to be removed. However, residents should be aware that the Chilliwack River presents ongoing flood and erosion risk to the Electoral Area community and damage to bank protection works in Sheldon Road area may have increased vulnerabilities to flooding and erosion.
