Join Electoral Area Director Terry Raymond and FVRD staff online on Tuesday, October 5 to talk about an upcoming Assent Voting Opportunity (or Referendum). The Referendum will be to vote on a ten year loan of up to \$170,000 for the FVRD to purchase land and buildings at 47715 Alder Road, in Boston Bar, BC for the new home of the Boston Bar Firehall.

Participate Via Zoom

You can participate in the Zoom meeting by phone, computer, smartphone, or tablet.

Phone

1. Dial any one of the following numbers:
1-778-907-2071, 1-647-558-0588, or 1-438-809-7799.
2. Enter Meeting ID **870 870 1785** followed by the # sign.
3. If the meeting has not already started, press # to wait for the host to start the meeting.
4. If you wish to speak, press *9. This will notify staff that you have raised your hand.
5. When it is your turn to speak you will be prompted to unmute your microphone.
6. Press *6 to unmute yourself.
7. Once you are done speaking, press *6 to mute yourself again.

Computer, smartphone, or tablet

1. Type in the following Zoom link: <https://us02web.zoom.us/j/8708701785>
2. If you wish to speak, click the “Raise Hand” feature in the controls at the bottom of the Zoom window. This will notify staff that you have raised your hand.
3. Staff will unmute your microphone when it is your turn to ask your question.
4. A prompt will appear to confirm you would like to be unmuted. Once you accept the prompt, you will have the opportunity to ask your question.
5. Once your question has ended, you will be muted again.
