RFQ Name: Island 22 Regional Park Trail Resurfacing

1. Can you clarify the depth/thickness for Schedules B, C, D? What is the breakdown of road base and crusher dust?

The breakdown for the 150mm of end thickness for new trails will be:

- 75mm of 19mm road base (mmcd)
- 75mm crusher dust

Existing trails with tread will have 150mm of new crusher dust after compaction. This will allow us to plane the trails in the future instead of adding more material.

2. Will clearing be required for the sections of new trail?

Yes. Sod and soil will have to be excavated prior to the addition of road base and crusher dust.

3. Will any filter fabric be required for the new sections of trail?

Yes. A light landscape fabric is required (not woven geotextile fabric).

4. Are there specifications for type of crusher dust used?

Yes. Please use gravel with bluish tint (quarry rock). Linterra and Chilliwack gravel are local businesses that provide this type of gravel.

5. Will the dog park need to remain open for the duration of the resurfacing project?

No, we can close the dog park for a duration within reason.

6. For the short section of new trail being built within the small dog area, does the stump need to be removed?

Yes.

7. Can we use the parking lot as a staging area?

Yes.

8. What if we encounter areas needing drainage improvement, culverts, or trail edge stabilization that goes beyond the scope of the RFQ?

We can add an addition to the RFQ should this situation arise.

9. Are we able to back down 2-ton dump trucks on the 3m wide trail for material delivery/excavation?

Yes

10. Will all trails be closed off to the public during construction?
