The ideal candidate must have:

- » Knowledge of local government service delivery and air quality management practices is preferred, and knowledge of related legislation, policies and procedures would be an asset.

- » Strong communication and interpersonal skills, including the ability to express thoughts and ideas clearly, and converse with a wide range of people including technical consultants, elected officials, staff, and the general public.
