We have an exciting opportunity for a qualified candidate to fill the full-time position of Utilities Technician III. We currently manage 14 water systems and 6 sewer systems. Our water and sewer systems use a wide range of technologies from the more established to the newest and most innovative.

Under the direction of the Manager of Operations, the Utilities Technician III will assist with the efficient and economical operation in the maintenance of existing public utilities which include supervising and inspecting of water and sewer connections, setting up and supervising preventative maintenance programs, supporting the ongoing operation and maintenance of grounds and physical plants, advising on and/or supervising limited maintenance of pool and arena systems and other water and sewer operations of the Regional District. The incumbent will also assist in the identification of construction priorities and the preparation of cost estimate reports or resources for budget purposes; responsible for overall monitoring of contacts, including cost control and budget tracking, quality control, assessment of efficiency, approval of project change orders in accordance with the FVRD Purchasing and Procurement Policy and Procedure, and identification of potential problems or issues.

The ideal candidate must have:

- » Completion of Grade 12 supplemented by an accredited post-secondary program in Water and Wastewater Technology plus extensive experience in utilities operation and training in water/wastewater treatment, water distribution, wastewater collection and hydraulics, or an equivalent of education and experience;
- » Solid knowledge of computer operation with respect to operation logistics equipment, and ability to carry out electronic troubleshooting, make or direct repairs to logistic systems;
- » Working knowledge of the Drinking Water Protection Legislation, and the Municipal Sewage Regulation;
- » Working knowledge of Service Area Bylaws;
- » Ability to effectively direct the work of others, and monitor the work of contractors;
- » EOCP Level III Certification in Wastewater Treatment and or Water Distribution
Or EOCP Level II Certification Water Treatment, Water Distribution, and Wastewater Collection, and Wastewater Treatment;
- » Ability to work independently with limited supervision, effectively handle conflicting priorities and emergency situations (sometimes late at night); and
- » Must possess a valid Driver's License.

The job rate for this full-time union position is \$48.82 per hour plus a competitive and comprehensive health, dental, and vision package and enrollment in the Municipal Pension Plan.
