We have an exciting opportunity for qualified candidates to fill the full-time position of Environmental Policy Analyst (Air Quality). Under the direction of the Manager of Environmental Services, a primary function of this position is to represent the FVRD and to actively participate, contribute to, and/or oversee several key interagency committees, task forces, and working groups relating to air quality and the airshed. The Environmental Policy Analyst is also responsible for air quality policy development and evaluation, data analysis, program coordination, scientific review and interpretation of potential environmental and socio-economic impacts within the region, and reporting to the Regional Board on current air quality or climate change issues and initiatives.

Required knowledge, experience, and abilities:

- » A Master's degree in Environmental Sciences, Environmental Resource Management, Environmental Engineering, or other similar degree is preferred, in addition to related experience or equivalent combination of education and experience;
- » Preferably five (5) years' experience in local government service delivery and knowledge of legislation, policies and procedures pertaining to Regional Districts and related environmental matters;
- » Experience in project management, conducting research, feasibility studies and risk assessments;
- » Ability to establish and maintain positive and effective working relationships with consultants, contractors, stakeholders, senior staff, co-workers, team members, advisory bodies and the public
- » Strong communication skills, interpersonal and presentation skills, including the ability to express thoughts and ideas clearly, and converse with a wide range of people including technical consultants, senior staff, and the general public
- » Excellent writing skills, with the ability to write in a clear and concise manner, and to prepare well written technical and administrative reports;
- » Ability to work independently, exercise good judgement, and effectively handle conflicting priorities and non-routine situations
- » Must possess a valid Driver's Licence.

The start rate for these full-time Union positions is \$37.74 per hour plus a comprehensive benefit package. Upon successful completion of the required six-month probationary period, the rate will increase to \$44.39 per hour.
