- » Experience in local government service delivery including engineering and utilities;
- » Experience in public engagement, managing projects, conducting research and feasibility studies;
- » Strong communication and interpersonal skills, including the ability to express thoughts and ideas clearly, and converse with technical consultants, staff and the general public;
- » Excellent writing skills, with the ability to write in a clear and concise manner, and to prepare well written technical and administrative reports, and make effective presentations;
- » Ability to establish and maintain positive and effective working relationships with consultants, contractors, stakeholders, staff, elected officials, advisory bodies and the public;
- » Must possess a valid Driver's Licence.
