- Advanced knowledge of local and wide area network technologies, standards and protocols, including the ability to design, configure and troubleshoot complex network routing;
- Advanced network security knowledge with Cisco and/or Fortinet security appliance, HP switches and familiarity with the SANS Institute 20 critical controls for network security or similar best practice;
- Considerable knowledge of SAN and flash storage arrays with NetApp, Nimble or Dell appliance;
- Considerable knowledge of backup and disaster recovery technologies such as Veeam and VMware Site Recovery Manager;
- Ability to maintain peak overall systems performance through system monitoring and analysis, performance tuning; troubleshooting system hardware, software, and networks;
- Ability to install new or rebuild existing services and hardware, peripherals, settings, and storage, to achieve operational requirements and project specifications.
