Club Child re-opening on September 14

We are excited to announce that our after school child care program, Club Child, will re-open on September 14, 2020, for the 2020-2021 school year.

REGISTRATION DETAILS

Full-time spaces can be reserved by contacting the Hope & Area Recreation Centre at 604-869-2304. As per our COVID-19 Safety Plan, we cannot offer drop-in registrations at this time, however this may be considered at a later date.

Registration packages can be picked up at the Hope and Area Recreation Centre starting September 3, 2020. Please call the rec centre at 604-869-2304 to schedule a package pick up time or we can email you the package. Fully completed registration packages must be submitted to reserve a child's spot.

Full time (5 days per week): \$159.10/month (\$9.25/day)

Dates

The Club Child program coincides with the School District 78 calendar. If School District 78 is closed due to a professional development day, weather or other circumstances, Club Child will also be closed.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

- » Children will be assessed by the Daycare Attendant at the start of Club Child. If a child appears ill or has symptoms associated with COVID-19, the parent/caregiver will be called immediately and asked to pick up the child.
- » Entrances and exits to Club Child will be from the outside (external doors).
- » Enhanced cleaning and disinfection of equipment and surfaces
- » A set of inside shoes for children is required to ensure the floor and Gymnasium remains clean and sanitary (these will be stored at Club Child).
- » No outside toys or games are permitted.

- » No shared equipment, food or supplies are permitted (except for siblings in the same household).
- » Bottled water and pre-packaged snacks will be provided to each child daily.
- » Pre-packaged craft supplies, stationery, and games will be provided to each child weekly.
- » Activities that can be performed with adequate space between children and staff will be encouraged.
- » Outdoor spaces will be utilized as often as possible
- » Hand hygiene practices will be enforced before after outdoor play

Additional information will be provided in the registration package and the Club Child Parent and Caregiver Handbook. The *Club Child COVID-19 Safety Plan* will be posted on our website by September 14.

Thank you for your patience and understanding while we work to ensure that Club Child is safe under the new requirements and guidelines. We have worked with School District 78 and Fraser Health to ensure Club Child will be a safe and welcoming environment during these challenging times.

We look forward to welcoming you back to Club Child and will continue to work on ensuring the safety, comfort and wellbeing of all Club Child participants and families.
