

EVACUATION ORDER AMENDMENT

Electoral Area B - Alexandra Bridge to Sawmill Creek

Whereas a state of local emergency was declared on July 31, 2026, by the Fraser Valley Regional District pursuant to Section 95 of the Emergency and Disaster Management Act due to wildfire within the jurisdiction of the Fraser Valley Regional District;

And whereas an evacuation order amendment (Order No.: 26-04587-2026-08-27(c)) was made by the Fraser Valley Regional District pursuant to Section 107 (1)(c) and (d) of the Emergency and Disaster Management Act, effective August 27, 2026, for the area of Electoral Area B – Alexandra Bridge to Sawmill Creek due to Brunswick Creek Complex (V10742) and Ainslie Creek (V10755) wildfires within the jurisdiction of the Fraser Valley Regional District ("Evacuation Order Amendment");

And whereas the threat of wildfire is reduced;

The Evacuation Order Amendment is repealed and hereby replaced by this Evacuation Order amendment, effective September 1, 2026, at 4:00 pm as for the following areas:

The Evacuation Order has been downgraded to an **Evacuation Alert** for the following properties:

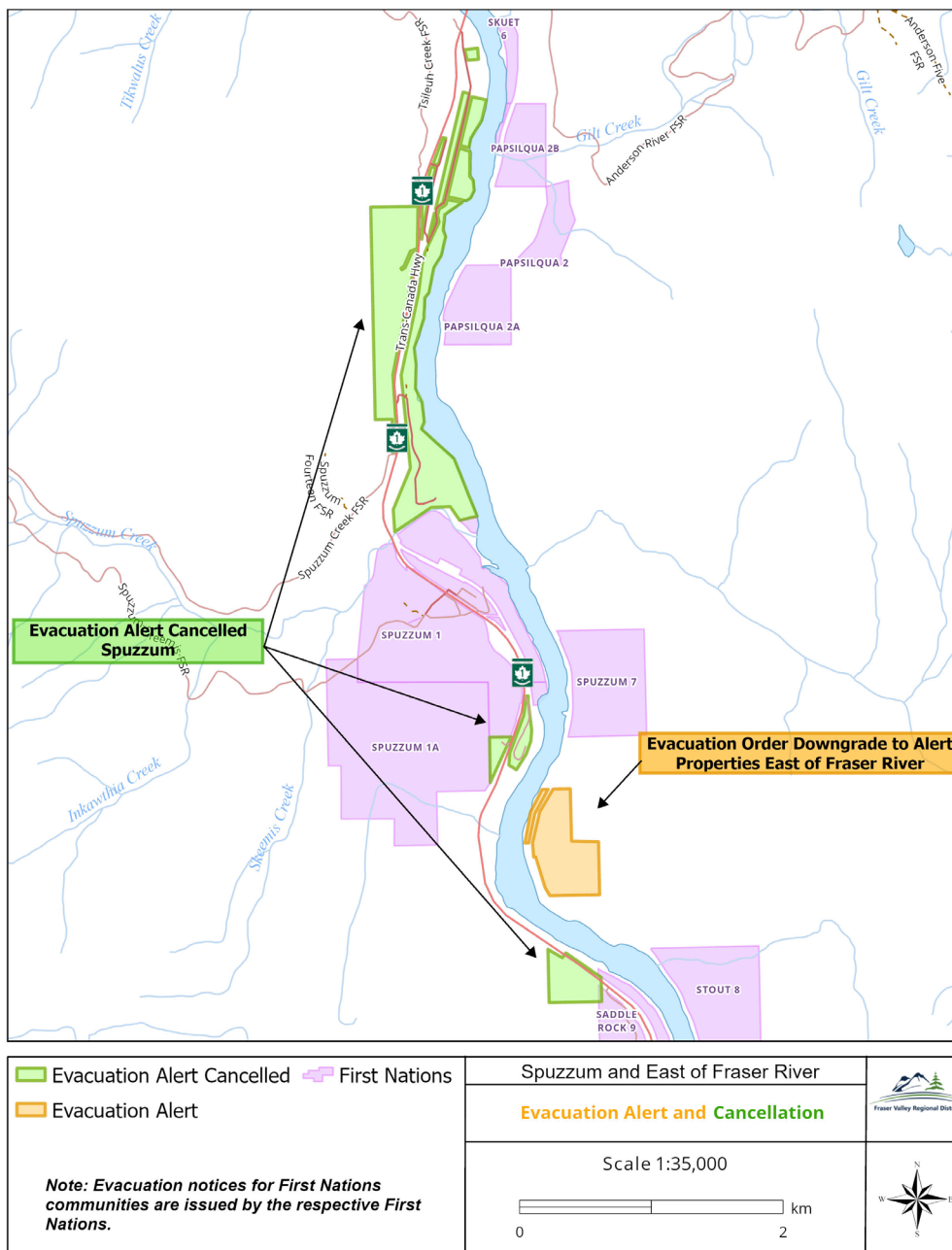
