

DECLARATION OF STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY ORDER

July 04, 2026, at 5:00 pm

Electoral Area A – Brunswick Wildfire – V10742

WHEREAS there is wildfire within the jurisdiction of the Fraser Valley Regional District;

AND WHEREAS the wildfire poses an existing or imminent threat to people and property within the Electoral Area A;

AND WHEREAS prompt coordination of action or special regulation of persons or property is required to protect the health, safety or well-being of persons or the safety of property or objects or sites of heritage value;

NOW THEREFORE:

I DECLARE, pursuant to Section 95 (1) of the Emergency and Disaster Management Act that a state of local emergency exists in in Electoral Area A due to wildfire which continues to exacerbate the potential harms to people, property, infrastructure and the environment.

Per Section 97 (1) of the Emergency and Disaster Management Act, the state of local emergency will remain in force for fourteen days, until the end of July 18, 2026, unless cancelled by the Fraser Valley Regional District or the Minister of Emergency Management and Climate Readiness, or extended by the Fraser Valley Regional District with the approval of the Minister of Emergency Management and Climate Readiness.
