Due to the ongoing fire situation we cannot ensure the quality of the water with regular monitoring practices. As a precaution water from this source **MUST** be disinfected prior to use for:

- DRINKING
- BRUSHING TEETH
- MAKING ICE (dispose of old ice)
- WASHING FOODS THAT WILL BE EATEN RAW
- COOKING
- WASHING DISHES

DISINFECTION PROCEDURES

PREFERRED METHOD - BOILING:

Bring water to a full rolling boil for 2 minutes:

- Let water cool sufficiently before drinking
- Disinfected water should be stored in the refrigerator in a covered, sanitary container

SECONDARY METHOD - HOUSEHOLD BLEACH (5% Chlorine):

Add 5 milliliters (1 Teaspoon) of 5% plain household bleach per liter of water and let stand for a minimum of 30 minutes before use.

- If taste / odour are too strong, let stand uncovered for several hours or overnight before drinking.

Water used for hand washing or bathing does not need to be disinfected. Supervision of children is necessary while bathing or using backyard pools so water is not ingested
