

Boston Bar Water System

Stage 4 Water Conservation Measures

As of July 22nd, 2026, the Fraser Valley Regional District has implemented Stage 4 Water Conservation Measures under the *Fraser Valley Regional District Electoral Area Water Conservation Regulation Bylaw No. 7387, 2016*.

During Stage 4 Water Conservation Measures, a person **shall not**:

- a) **Water a lawn, garden or landscaped area on a property;**
- b) **irrigate golf courses, playing fields, turf farms, sod farms, tree farms or nurseries;**
- c) **Fill a swimming pool, hot tub or garden pond;**
- d) **Wash a vehicle or boat;**
- e) **Wash sidewalks, driveways, walls, roofs or other outdoor surfaces; and/or**
- f) **Hand water lawns or plants.**

During Stage 4 Water Conservation Measures, the following uses **are permitted**:

- a) **Prevention or control of fires.**
- b) **For the health or safety of any person.**

Any person found to be in violation of these measures by be fined \$500 for Contravening Stage 4 Water Conservation Measures per offense under the *Fraser Valley Regional District Bylaw Offence Notice Enforcement Bylaw No. 1415, 2017*

If water conservation measures are not implemented and demand continues to outstrip supply the Boston Bar Water System may be required to be isolated to prevent failure of infrastructure.
