

DECLARATION OF LOCAL RECOVERY PERIOD ORDER

January 21, 2026 8:22 pm

Electoral Area E – Sheldon and Wilson Road Neighbourhoods

WHEREAS a state of local emergency was declared in relation to an atmospheric river within the jurisdiction of the Fraser Valley Regional District on December 10, 2025 through:

- December 10, 2025 – State of Local Emergency Area E
- January 7, 2026 - State of Local Emergency Extension and Amendment – Area E west of Allison Pool

AND WHEREAS the threat to life and property from the atmospheric river emergency has subsided sufficiently, and it is appropriate to transition out of a state of local emergency;

AND WHEREAS the Fraser Valley Regional is satisfied that the use of recovery powers under Section 118 of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* are required in order to recover from the emergency:

- Using or control the use of land
- Authorize a qualified person to provide a service or give assistance.
- Authorize entry into structures or onto land to take emergency measures.
- Authorize or require the construction, alteration, removal, or demolition of works.


NOW THEREFORE:

I DECLARE, pursuant to Section 98 (1) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*, that a local recovery period exists in the area of the Area E Sheldon Road and Wilson Road neighbourhoods;

The following emergency instruments remain in effect during the local recovery period, with the following prohibitions, requirements, limits, or conditions, if any:

- Using or control the use of land
- Authorize a qualified person to provide a service or give assistance.
- Authorize entry into structures or onto land to take emergency measures.
- Authorize or require the construction, alteration, removal, or demolition of works.

Per Section 100(1) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*, the local recovery period will remain in force for 90 days until the end of the day on Tuesday, April 21, 2026, unless amended or cancelled by the Fraser Valley Regional District or the Minister of Emergency Management and Climate Readiness.
