

EVACUATION ALERT

August 24, 2025

Electoral Area B – Yale north to Spuzzum Creek Road including east and west side of the Fraser River

An **Evacuation Alert** has been issued by the Fraser Valley Regional District at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) because of risk to life and safety from the Sailor Bar Wildfire (V11606).

The Fraser Valley Regional District has issued an **Evacuation Alert** for the following areas:

- Yale, Electoral Area B
- Properties on Spuzzum Creek Road
 - Private Properties on both the east and west side of the Fraser River from Yale north to Spuzzum Creek Road
- Crown lands in the mapped area

This alert does not apply to First Nations reserve lands. See information provided by Spuzzum First Nation or Yale First Nation on their websites and social media sources.





WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- 1. Locate all family members and choose a meeting place outside the evacuation alert area in case you're separated if an Evacuation Order is issued.
- 2. Pack essential items, including:
 - · Government-issued ID
 - Medications and prescriptions
 - Eyeglasses or hearing aids
 - · Important documents (insurance, credit, mortgage/tenancy)
 - · Care needs for children, pets, and dependents
 - · If space and time allow: keepsakes and comfort items
- 3. Make plans for family and household members needing help:
 - Prepare to evacuate persons with disabilities (bring mobility aids/supports)
 - · Account for seniors, children, and connect with neighbours needing assistance
- 4. Plan for animals:
 - · Take pets with you: have carriers, leashes, food, and vet records ready
 - · Move livestock to a safe location if possible
- 5. Arrange transportation for everyone in your household:
 - · Fill the gas tanks of vehicles
 - If you need evacuation transportation, arrange it with family, friends or neighbours.
- 6. Plan where you will stay:
 - · Make arrangements with family or friends
 - Accommodations may be limited to cots in comingled shelters during emergencies.
- 7. If you'll need public aide assistance with lodging, food, or essentials after evacuation:
 - Ensure you have a BCeID digital app ID set up
 - Then set up or update your BC Emergency Support Services (ESS) profile now at <u>ess.gov.bc.ca</u> to receive the independent emergency *Sheltering Allowance* support funds from the province
 - Review your home or tenant insurance coverage for evacuation related expenses
- 8. Follow instructions from emergency officials and be ready to leave immediately if an Evacuation Order is issued.
