

EVACUATION ALERT

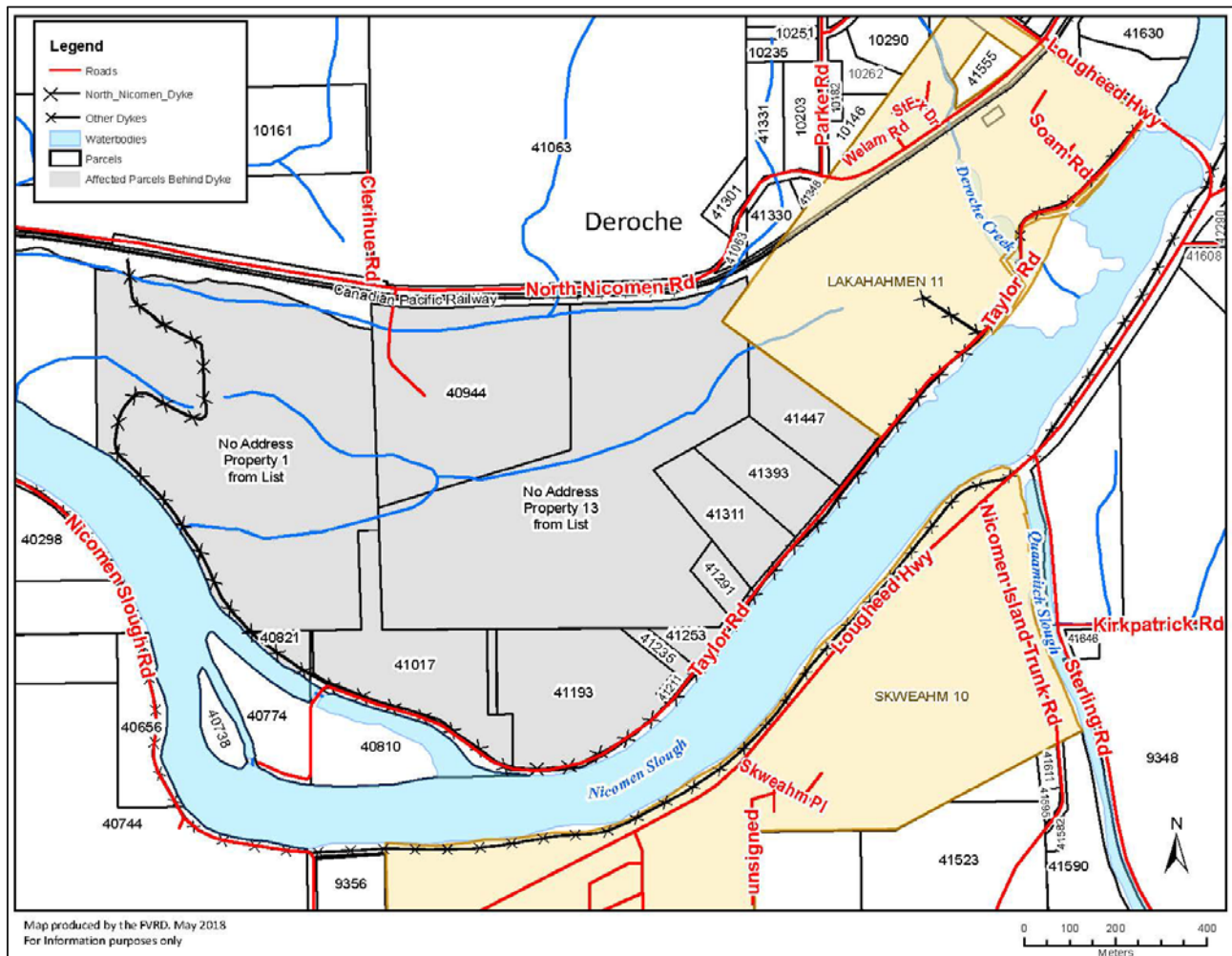

Lands in the North Nicomen and Taylor Road Area, FVRD Electoral Area "G"

Pursuant to the BC Emergency Program Act, an **Evacuation Alert** has been issued by the Fraser Valley Regional District (FVRD) at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).

Because of the potential danger to life safety and health, the FVRD has issued this Evacuation Alert for the following areas:

This alert applies to the properties in FVRD Area "G" behind the North Nicomen Dike approximately between North Nicomen Road and Taylor Road as shown in gray on the map below:



This alert has been issued to help prepare residents if an evacuation becomes necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

What You Should Do Now

Upon notification of an Evacuation Alert, you should be prepared for an Evacuation Order by:

- Locating all family members and designate a reception centre outside of the evacuation area, should an evacuation be called while separated.
- Gathering essential items such as medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e. insurance, identification, and emergency contact numbers), and immediate care needs. Have these items readily available for an immediate departure.
- Preparing to move any disabled persons and/or children.
- Make arrangements for pets and livestock and move them to a safe area.
- Arrange for transport of your household members and accommodation if possible. In the event of an Evacuation Order, Reception Centres will be opened if needed.
- Monitor news sources for up to date information including the locations of Reception Centres.
