

## EVACUATION ORDER PARTIAL RESCIND

November 20, 2021 at 2:30 pm

### **Bridal Falls Area, FVRD Electoral Area D**

The Evacuation ORDER, pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the BC *Emergency Program Act* issued by the Fraser Valley Regional District on November 15, 2021, and expanded on November 16, 2021 has been partially rescinded.

Geotechnical assessments have been completed to understand which areas remain at risk, and which areas are considered safe. The evacuation order has been partially rescinded for areas found to be safe based on geotechnical findings. As further investigation is completed, additional information may provided in relation to the area remaining under Evacuation Order.

The Evacuation Order is rescinded/cancelled from the following properties as shown on the map:

53730 Bridal Falls Road

53770 Bridal Falls Road

10381 Popkum Road South

The Evacuation Order **remains** on the following properties as shown on the map:

Part of 53790 Popkum Road South

10380 Popkum Road South (Crown Land area)

### **What you should do:**

- » Determine if you need fuel in your vehicle before returning to the community
- » Consider if groceries and food providers in your community were impacted. If so, bring at least three days of food home and essential supplies home with you (e.g. medications, pet supplies) because the local grocers may not have adequate stock
- » Check for any damage to electrical or gas equipment that may have been caused by floodwater. Don't turn anything back on until the equipment has been inspected by a licensed gas or electrical contractor.
