

DECLARING A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY (SOLE)

EXTENSION REQUEST

WHEREAS life and property remain at risk due to atmospheric event and heavy rainfall causing overland flooding and mudslides within the jurisdiction of Fraser Valley Regional District in the Fraser Valley Regional District;

AND WHEREAS response to this overland flooding and mudslides continues to require use of the emergency powers to regulate persons or property to protect the health, safety, and welfare of people or to limit damage to property;


