

## EVACUATION ALERT

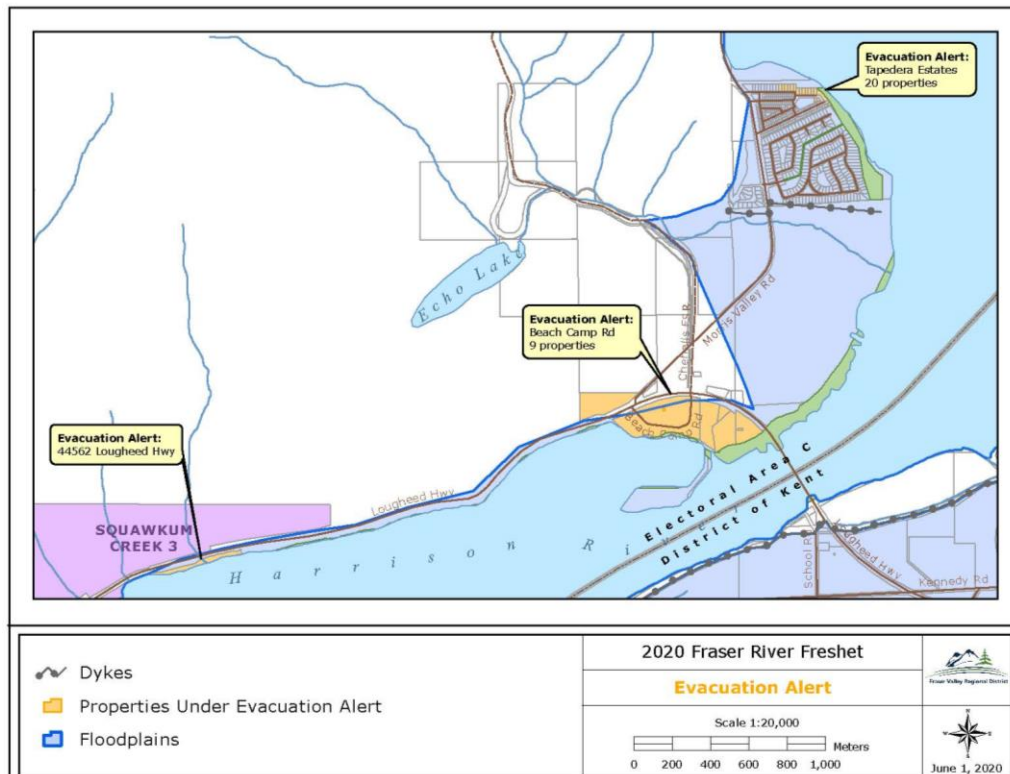
### Lands Not Protected by Dikes, FVRD Electoral Area C

Pursuant to the BC Emergency Program Act, an Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Fraser Valley Regional District (FVRD) at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).

Because of the potential danger to life safety and health, the FVRD has issued this Evacuation Alert for the following areas:

**This alert applies to all undiked lands – land not protected by dikes or outside of the diking system in FVRD Electoral Area C, as shown in YELLOW and indicated below:**

- » Harrison Bay Resort and RV Park - 44562 Lougheed Highway, all units
- » Beach Camp Road
- » Harrison Bay Boat Launch residential properties (east of Can Forest Products Rd/Chehalis FSR and south of Lougheed Hwy)
- » Tapadera Estates – 14600 Morris Valley Road - 20 units
  - » #17, #18, #59, #60, #61, #62, #63, #64, #65, #66, #67, #68, #69, #70, #71
  - » #159, #160, #161, #162, #163



This Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises of property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

### WHAT YOU NEED TO DO WHEN AN EVACUATION ALERT IS IN EFFECT

Upon notification of an evacuation alert, you need to be preparing for an evacuation order by:

- » Locating all family members.
- » Designating a place outside the evacuation area to meet should an evacuation occur.
- » Gathering essential items such as:
  - › Medications,
  - › Eyeglasses,
  - › Valuable papers (i.e. insurance, identification, and emergency contact numbers)
  - › Immediate care needs
- » Having essential items and irreplaceable personal items ready for quick departure.
- » Preparing to move
  - › Disabled persons (with mobility aids & supports required to maintain independence)
  - › Children
  - › Elderly
  - › Immobile neighbours
- » Having supplies, vet records, and containment needs ready for pets.
- » Implementing a plan to move livestock to safety.
- » Arranging for transport of your household members.
- » Arranging accommodation for your family if possible.
- » In the event of an evacuation order Emergency Support Services (ESS) sites may be activated for the purposes of family reunification, referrals to essential service providers, and Group Lodging.
- » Monitoring credible news sources for information on evacuation orders and locations of ESS Sites.
