Recently, there have been several incidents of garbage dumped outside the gate of the transfer station when it's closed. Dumping garbage at the transfer station outside of operating hours is considered illegal dumping. **Please DO NOT dump garbage outside when the transfer station is closed.** For hours of operation visit fvrd.ca/garbage.

How do I report illegally dumped garbage?

If you witness a violation, please call the BC Ministry of Environment's Report All Poachers and Polluters (RAPP) hotline at 1-877-952-RAPP (7277) to report the incident.



How does illegally dumped garbage affect my community?

Illegally dumping garbage is a form of environmental pollution and can have significant negative effects on wildlife and the community such as:

- » Damaging plants and harming wildlife
- » Attracting wildlife to residential areas
- » Creating an eyesore for the community
- » Increasing fees for garbage disposal to offset the cost for cleanups
