

Boston Bar Water System

Stage 2 Water Conservation Measures

As of August 10th 2026, the Fraser Valley Regional District has implemented Stage 2 Water Conservation Measures under the *Fraser Valley Regional District Electoral Area Water Conservation Regulation Bylaw No. 7387, 2016*.

During Stage 2 Water Conservation Measures, no person shall use a watering system to water a lawn, garden or landscaped area on a property **except**:

- a) **At properties with even numbered civic addresses, on Wednesdays and Saturdays between 8:00pm and 12:00 midnight.**
- b) **At properties with odd numbered civic addresses, on Thursdays and Sundays between 8:00 pm and 12:00 midnight.**

During Stage 2 Water Conservation Measures, the following uses **are permitted**:

- a) **Hand watering of flower gardens, vegetable gardens, decorative planters, shrubs or trees. Drip irrigation for watering flower gardens, vegetable gardens, decorative planters and shrubs or trees is also permitted**
- b) **Prevention or control of fires**
- c) **For health or safety of any person**

During Stage 2 Water Conservation Measures, the following uses are **not permitted**:

- a) **Hand watering of lawns or grass.**

Any person found to be in violation of these measures by be fined \$100 for Contravening Stage 2 Water Conservation Measures per offense under the *Fraser Valley Regional District Bylaw Offence Notice Enforcement Bylaw No. 1415, 2017*
